2011 Application Process For Summer Employment Lifeguards, Gate Guards, Ticket Staff, Maintenance Staff

- (1) Pick up an application from Sea Bright Borough Hall: 1167 Ocean Ave. (OR) download an application from Sea Bright's Web Site: (www.seabrightnj.org).
- (2) Return the completed application to Sea Bright Borough Hall. Applicants who are hired will be notified to come in and complete the required paperwork. All paperwork must be submitted prior to starting work.

PAPERWORK INCLUDES:

- (a) Copy of your Driver's License
- (b) Copy of your Social Security Card
- (c) Copy of your Student ID
- (d) Federal I-9 Form
- (e) 2011 W-4 Tax Form
- (f) Working Papers (If you are under 18 yrs. of age) **NOTE:** No one under the age of 18 can be hired without working papers. This is the law!

(3) ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS (FOR LIFEGUARDS ONLY):

- (a) Pass the United States Lifesaving Association's qualifying 500 meter swim test in under 10 minutes.
The swim test will be held at the Jewish Community Center 100 Grant Ave., Deal, N.J.
ON: Friday, May 20, 2011 at 4:00pm. ALL LIFEGUARDS MUST PASS THIS SWIM TEST BEFORE THE BEACH OPENS FULL TIME.
NOTE: Obviously, 10 min is not a competitive time for 500m, but is the basic measure of the swimming ability required by the USLA for open water lifeguard certification and employment as an ocean lifeguard by the Borough of Sea Bright. No exceptions!
- (b) Provide Sea Bright with a current MD's report, certifying that you are in good health and able to take the swim test & perform your duties as a lifeguard.
- (c) Provide copies of your lifesaving credentials (CPR, AED, 1st Aid, etc.) We will train new recruits, but it is a plus if you already have certifications.

I am looking forward to seeing the returning crew again, and meeting the new recruits.
