





BUDGET MESSAGE																																																											
<p>The Mayor and Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, County of Monmouth hereby submit the 2011 Municipal Budget. This budget is introduced with a proposed increase in the tax rate of \$0.03 per \$100.00 of assessed value. This proposed increase is within the 2% Municipal Tax Levy CAP. The 2011 Municipal Budget is negatively impacted by decreased revenues in the 2010 Municipal Budget. The Tax Collection Rate is once again below 97% thereby reducing the regeneration of surplus to support this budget. While State Aid remains stable, a 22% increase in pension payments to the state pension funds and a 13% increase in the cost of health benefits through the state health benefits program and major factors in this tax rate increase. The Borough is also working toward implementation of the Smart Growth Program. To do so, the Borough will be incurring debt and must provide adequate down payments and demonstrate the ability to repay the debt. The Borough Council continues to research and implement shared services programs and regionalization of services where appropriate.</p> <p>BUDGET CAP NJS 40A:4-45.1 et seq. as amended by PL 1990, Chapters 89 and 95, places limits on municipal expenditures commonly referred to as "CAPS". The Borough is approaching the implementation phase of the Borough of Sea Bright Smart Futures Planning Program. Several projects within this capital budget are directly in support of the initiatives outlined in said program.

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


