

RESOLUTION No. 59-2014
**AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH OF SEA BRIGHT TO APPLY FOR
THE NEW JERSEY OFFICE OF ATTORNEY GENERAL
DEPARTMENT OF LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY GRANT**

Councilmember Leckstein introduced and offered for adoption the following resolution; seconded by Councilmember Murphy.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of Sea Bright in the County of Monmouth, has a need to improve pedestrian safety in the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Office of Attorney General, Department of Law and Public Safety has a grant that can pay for police personnel to enforce crosswalk laws, education for motorists and pedestrians and increased signage; and

WHEREAS, this grant would provide funding for police personnel that the Borough is intending on hiring to assist with reducing pedestrian/motor vehicle conflicts, as well as enhance any streetscaping project in the future by paying for some of the improvements; and

WHEREAS, the maximum grant amount is \$15,000, with no local match; and

WHEREAS, the deadline to apply for this grant is April 30, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of Sea Bright in the County of Monmouth desires to apply for this pedestrian safety grant from the Jersey Office of Attorney General, Department of Law and Public Safety; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Borough of Sea Bright is authorized to apply for said Grant and execute any and all necessary documents associated with the Grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the persons whose names appear below (and any successors and assigns) are authorized to sign the grant agreement or any other document in connection therewith; and


