

RESOLUTION NO. 89-2014

REQUESTING THE DIVISION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICES GRANT APPROVAL OF A DEDICATION BY RIDER OF REVENUES RECEIVED FOR PUBLIC DEFENDER

Councilmember Leckstein introduced and offered for adoption the following Resolution seconded by Councilmember Kelly;

WHEREAS, permission is required of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services for approval as a dedication by rider of revenues received by a municipality when the revenue is not subject to reasonably accurate estimates in advance; and,

WHEREAS, P.L.1997, c. 256 permits the municipality to impose an application fee not to exceed \$50.00 to offset the costs of retaining a municipal public defender(s) as a use if consistent with the laws of the State and of the United States; and,

WHEREAS, NJSA 40A:4-39 provides the dedicated revenues anticipated from the Public Defender Trust are hereby anticipated as revenue and are hereby appropriated for the purpose to which said revenue is dedicated by statute or other legal requirement that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services may approve expenditures of said monies by dedication by rider;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, County of Monmouth, as follows:


1. The Borough Council does hereby request permission of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to utilize funds received for Public Defender for the stated purpose.
