**REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS  
FOR  
DEVELOPMENT OF A GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEM**

Councilmember Keeler introduced and offered for adoption the following Resolution;  
seconded by Councilmember Kelly;

**WHEREAS**, Superstorm Sandy highlighted the lack of digital geographic information that was available and accessible to the Borough of Sea Bright, and

**WHEREAS**, this lack of geographic information system (GIS) data caused delays and other issues for the Borough of Sea Bright in its response to the storm and its aftermath, and

**WHEREAS**, having improved access to GIS data and enhanced ability to use this data will allow the Borough to better prepare for, respond more quickly to and be more resilient to future storm events or other emergencies, and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough expects to receive a grant from the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs that will provide funding for the development of such a system.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright to advertise for the request for proposals for these services.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the following:


