

RESOLUTION NO. 152-2014
AUTHORIZING TRANSFER OF TITLE
POLICE DEPARTMENT VEHICLE
TO SEA BRIGHT FIRST AID

WHEREAS, the Borough of Sea Bright Police Department is in possession of a 2007 four-door, Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptor (VIN No. 2FAPF 71WX7 X1552 68) which is no longer needed for public use; and

WHEREAS, the Sea Bright First Aid, Inc. is desirous of receiving the above referenced vehicle for the First Aid Chief; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A: 11-36 (7), by resolution of the governing body, a contracting unit may sell personal property no longer needed for public use without public bidding when the sale is made to another government unit; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT BE RESOLVED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright in the County of Monmouth that it hereby approves the transfer of the above-referenced vehicle to Sea Bright First Aid, Inc. for the sum of \$1.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, County of Monmouth that they do hereby authorize the Borough Clerk to transfer title to Sea Bright First Aid, Inc., and a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the following:


