

RESOLUTION NO. 167-2014
AUTHORIZING THE FORMATION OF A BICYCLE ADVISORY
COMMITTEE TO UNDERTAKE THE CREATION OF A BICYCLE
PLAN FOR THE BOROUGH OF SEA BRIGHT

Councilmember Leckstein introduced and offered for adoption the following resolution; seconded by Councilmember Keeler:

WHEREAS, the intent of a Bicycle Plan is to initiate, guide and result in the development of a more bicycle friendly community in the Borough of Sea Bright; and

WHEREAS, the benefits of a Bicycle Plan include the guidelines for improving safety for pedestrians, bicyclists, children, and those who cannot afford a car or choose to live car free; providing bicycling connections to their place of employment, education, residence, recreation, retail centers and public facilities while promoting healthy lifestyles; creating more livable communities, furthering the Borough's Complete Streets policy; reducing traffic congestion and reliance on carbon fuels thereby reducing greenhouse gas emissions and saving money by incorporating sidewalks, bike lanes and other facilities, and safer transit amenities into the initial design of a project, thus sparing the expense of retrofits later; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Sea Bright wishes to develop a Bicycle Plan to enable safe access and mobility of pedestrians, bicyclists, transit users of all ages and abilities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Sea Bright appoint a Committee to create a Bicycle Plan for the Borough for consideration by Borough Council; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Committee will work with residents, businesses and visitors of Sea Bright, the New Jersey Department of Transportation, the New Jersey Bike and Pedestrian Coalition, neighboring communities and any and all organizations or departments who may assist in the development of a bicycle plan; and


