

RESOLUTION NO. 184-2014
Authorizing the Purchase of Self Contained Breathing Apparatus
for the Fire Department in the Borough of Sea Bright

WHEREAS, the Borough of Sea Bright wishes to purchase under State Contract No. A80961, Self Contained Breathing Apparatus listed on the attached proposals #52484 and #52580 from Action Fire Apparatus Co., Inc. d/b/a New Jersey Fire Equipment, 119-131 Route 22 East, Green Brook, NJ 08812 for an amount of \$78,283.31, and

WHEREAS, the purchase of goods and services by local contracting units is authorized by the Local Public Contracts Law, NJSA 40A:11-12; and

WHEREAS, Michael J. Bascom, Chief Financial Officer of the Borough of Sea Bright, has certified that funds in the amount of \$78,283.31 are available in the FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program Award for this contract.


