


RESOLUTION NO. 185-2014
Communications Shared Services Agreement
between Monmouth County and the Borough of Sea Bright

Councilmember Leckstein introduced and offered for adoption the following resolution; seconded by Councilmember Kelly:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Sea Bright wishes to renew its Shared Services Agreement with the Monmouth County Sheriff's Office, Communications Division for 9-1-1 Services; and,

WHEREAS, under the terms of the said Agreement, the Borough of Sea Bright will pay to the Monmouth County Sheriff's Office \$17,249.89 for the year 2015 and the annual fee thereafter shall be determined in accordance with the County's shared service proposal distributed to the Borough of Sea Bright on or about November 15th of the prior year, and


