

RESOLUTION NO. 196-2014

**Consideration of Bids Received for
Reconstruction of Six Bulkheads and New Pump Station**

Councilmember Leckstein introduced and offered for adoption the following Resolution, seconded by Councilmember Kelly:

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright authorized the receipt of bids for Reconstruction of Six Bulkheads and New Pump Station on October 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer did duly advertise on October 29, 2014 to receive bids on November 13, 2014 for Reconstruction of Six Bulkheads and New Pump Station; and

WHEREAS, in connection therewith (5) five bids were received from 1) Precise Construction, 1016 Highway 35, Freehold, NJ 07728, 2) R. Kremer & Son Marine Contractors, LLC, 253 Drum Point Road, Brick, NJ 08723, 3) Lucas Construction Group, Inc. 173 Amboy Road, Morganville, NJ 07751, 4) Marbro, Inc., 127 Pine Street, Montclair, NJ 07042, 5) J.E. Hannon Inc. T/A Bird Construction, 105 Harbor Inn Road, Bayville, NJ 08721; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer determined that the pricing exceeded the engineer's estimate for the project, therefore recommended the Borough of Sea Bright reject the aforementioned bids; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that the bids received for Reconstruction of Six Bulkheads and New Pump Station be and are hereby rejected; and and the Borough Engineer is hereby authorized to re-advertise for receipt of same; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Borough Clerk is hereby authorized to return all bid bonds and/or certified checks received for this particular bid item; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the following:


