

**RESOLUTION NO. 59-2015**

**Direct Emergency Dispatch Services Agreement  
between Monmouth County and the Borough of Sea Bright**

Councilmember Leckstein introduced and offered for adoption the following resolution; seconded by Councilmember Bills:

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Sea Bright wishes to enter into a Shared Services Agreement for Direct Emergency Dispatch Services with the Monmouth County Sheriff's Office, Communications Division; and

**WHEREAS**, under the terms of the said Agreement, the Communications Division will service as the Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) for the Borough of Sea Bright, and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Sea Bright will pay to the Monmouth County Sheriff's Office a fee for the year 2015 of \$82,729.00 which includes the following: Dispatch - \$65,650 and Fire/EMS/Computer Services - \$17,079.00; said fee will be pro-rated on a monthly basis according to the initial date full service begins; and

**CERTIFICATION OF FUNDS**, I, Michael J. Bascom, Chief Financial Officer of the Borough of Sea Bright do hereby certify that funds will be available in Monmouth County Dispatch Services for the purpose stated herein.


