

**RESOLUTION No. 83-2015**  
**ESTABLISHING ANCHORAGE BEACH**  
**WITH LIFEGUARDS IN ATTENDANCE**  
**FOR THE 2015 SUMMER SEASON**

Councilmember Leckstein introduced and offered for adoption the following Resolution; seconded by Councilmember Kelly:

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, has considered to operate Anchorage Beach, aka Block 23, Lot 11, commonly known as 909 Ocean Avenue in the Borough of Sea Bright; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2015 Summer Season, (Memorial Day through Labor Day) the Borough of Sea Bright will to open to the public, beach badges are required at a rate of \$8.00 per day and/or \$100.00 per season at Anchorage Beach; and

**WHEREAS**, Anchorage Beach will be supervised on weekends only; Lifeguards will be on duty from 9:00am – 5:00pm, Saturday and Sunday, unless otherwise indicated; and

**WHEREAS**, Beach Badges are not required on off days, (Monday thru Friday) Lifeguards will not be on duty during those off days, and

**WHEREAS**, the parking area at Anchorage Beach will be limited to beach badge holders only on Saturday and Sunday when the beach is guarded.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Borough of Sea Bright agrees to comply with all applicable federal and state laws; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a certified copy of this resolution be forwarded to the following:


