

RESOLUTION NO. 101-2015
Amending Resolution #73-2015
RE - CONSIDERATION OF AWARD
Reconstruction of Six Bulkheads and New Stormwater Pump Station

Councilmember Keeler introduced and offered the following Resolution for adoption; seconded by Councilmember Leckstein:

WHEREAS, the Borough Council approved Resolution #73-2015, awarding a contract to the lowest responsible bidder known as R. Kremer & Son Marine Contractors, LLC of Brick, New Jersey at the base bid price of \$1,199,880.00 on April 21, 2015 for the Reconstruction of Six Bulkheads and New Stormwater Pump Station; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer, Jaclyn Flor informed the Borough Council that the letter of April 21, 2015 to consider the award included the Base Bid, Alternative A1 and Alternative A2 with a Total Bid for Reconstruction of Six Bulkheads and New Stormwater Pump Station; and

WHEREAS, Resolution #73-2015, for the award of the Reconstruction of Six Bulkheads and New Stormwater Pump Station only addressed the base bid price to the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, for the re-consideration in connection therewith, the following four (4) bids represents the Base Bid, Alternative A1, Alternative A2 and the Total Bid amount as follows:

- 1) R. Kremer & Son Marine Contractors, LLC, Brick, NJ, total bid price of \$1,525,705.00;
- 2) Lucas Construction Group, Inc., Morganville, NJ, total bid price of \$1,633,355.00;
- 3) Precise Construction Inc., Freehold, NJ, total bid price of \$1,709,435.00;
- 4) Marbro, Inc., Montclair, NJ, total bid price of \$1,560,357.00;

and

WHEREAS, it was determined that R. Kremer & Son Marine Contractors, LLC is the lowest responsible bidder meeting the requirements as per the bid specifications for this bid; and

WHEREAS, the April 21, 2015, the letter from Jaclyn Flor, Borough Engineer recommended the contract be awarded to R. Kremer & Son Marine Contractors, LLC of Brick, New Jersey as per their bid proposal for the Reconstruction of Six Bulkheads and New Stormwater Pump Station at a cost not to exceed \$1,525,705.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the following:


