

**RESOLUTION No. 172-2016**  
**ACCEPTANCE OF "BUCKLE UP IN THE PARK 2016" GRANT FUNDING**  
**NEW JERSEY DIVISION OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY**

Councilmember Bills introduced and offered for adoption the following resolution; seconded by Councilmember Kelly:

**WHEREAS**, the safety and security of the citizens of the Borough of Sea Bright and surrounding areas is vitally important; and

**WHEREAS**, a large percentage of motor vehicle occupants injured in traffic accidents were not wearing seat belts; and

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the Attorney General, Division of Highway Traffic Safety launched its first "Buckle Up in the Park" campaign to be held on July 9, 16 and 23, 2016 in and around the Sandy Hook Recreational area to raise awareness about seat belt usage; and

**WHEREAS**, the Division of Highway Traffic Safety offered the Borough of Sea Bright Police Department reimbursement grant funding in the amount of \$1,800 to reimburse the Borough for enforcement overtime at a rate of \$50/hour; and

**WHEREAS**, on or about July 12, 2016, the Borough of Sea Bright Police Chief submitted an application and received approval from the Division of Highway Traffic Safety for the aforementioned grant; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that the appropriate officials are hereby authorized to effectuate the receipt of the aforementioned reimbursement grant funds in the total amount of \$1,800.00 from the Division of Highway Traffic Safety, Buckle Up In The Park 2016 Campaign; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a certified copy of this resolution be forwarded to the following:


