

RESOLUTION NO. 193-2016
A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF SEA BRIGHT
PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF PROJECT LABOR AGREEMENTS.

Councilmember Leckstein offered the following resolution and moved its adoption; seconded by Councilmember Kelly:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Sea Bright is engaged in a public works project to replace municipal facilities damaged and destroyed by Superstorm Sandy; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 52:38-1 et seq. permits the use of project labor agreements by public entities; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council finds that the use of public labor agreements will provide for the efficient, safe and timely completion of the project; and

WHEREAS, the use of project labor agreements will ensure a reliable source of skilled and experienced labor; provide standardized mechanisms for the settlement of work disputes; avoid the costly delays which can be caused by work disputes; and will further public policy objectives as to improved employment opportunities for minorities, women and the economically disadvantaged in the construction industry; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council finds that the use of project labor agreements will provide substantial benefit to the Borough and its residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright that the specifications for the Pavilion and the Municipal Complex shall include the requirement that the successful builder enter into a Project Labor Agreement, a copy of which shall be made a part of the specifications and a copy of which shall be maintained on file in the office of the Borough Clerk.


