

RESOLUTION NO. 56-2017
AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH
THE BOROUGH OF HIGHLANDS FOR STREET SWEEPING SERVICES

Councilmember Leckstein introduced and offered for adoption the following Resolution; seconded by Councilmember Lamia:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Sea Bright ("Sea Bright") and the Borough of Highlands ("Highlands") wish to enter into a Shared Services Agreement for the provision of street sweeping services by Highlands to Sea Bright; and

WHEREAS, the "Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act," N.J.S.A. 40:65-1, et seq., authorizes the approval of Shared Services Agreements by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, Sea Bright and Highlands agree that Highlands is to provide street sweeping services to Sea Bright per the terms of the Agreement attached; and

WHEREAS, with the above in mind, the parties wish to enter into the attached Shared Services Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the parties acknowledge and agree that they are associated for only the purposes set forth in the Agreement and any other duly ratified Shared Services Agreement between them, and that each is a public entity separate and distinct from the other.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey:

1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute and the Municipal Clerk to attest the attached Shared Services Agreement for street sweeping services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution and a copy of the attached Agreement be forwarded to the following:


