

RESOLUTION NO. 58-2017
**AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 193-2016 PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF PROJECT
LABOR AGREEMENTS PERTAINING TO THE BEACH PAVILION.**

Councilmember Leckstein introduced and offered for adoption the following resolution;
seconded by Councilmember Lamia:

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2016 the Borough Council adopted Resolution No. 193-2016 pertaining to the use of Project Labor Agreements in connection with the public works project to replace municipal facilities damaged and destroyed by Superstorm Sandy; and

WHEREAS, a notice to bidders and specifications for the construction of the New Beach Pavilion have been issued by the project architect; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has received objections to the inclusion of a Project Labor Agreement requirement in the contract for the Beach Pavilion; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council finds that the delays involving the construction of the New Beach Pavilion which would be caused by a dispute pertaining to the use of a project labor agreement would be detrimental to the Borough and its residents and that the benefits that can be derived from the use of a project labor agreement will still be available to the Borough in connection with the construction of the new municipal complex;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright that the project architect be and is hereby authorized and directed to issue an addendum to the specifications for the New Beach Pavilion in order to eliminate the requirement that a project labor agreement be utilized in connection with the construction of the project.


