

RESOLUTION NO. 142-2018
AUTHORIZING CLEAN OCEAN ACTION TO BRING BOOKER D. SURFDOG
ONTO THE BEACH FOR A CLEAN BEACH AWARENESS EVENT

Councilmember Leckstein introduced and offered for adoption the following Resolution; seconded by Councilmember Kelly:

WHEREAS, Clean Ocean Action has a promotional event scheduled on the Sea Bright Municipal Beach on Wednesday, September 5, 2018 at 12 noon to promote Clean Beach Awareness and the upcoming Dog Walk Fur Clean Water in Asbury Park; and

WHEREAS, as part of the event, Booker D. SurfDOG (the world class surf dog) is scheduled to make an appearance on her surfboard for about 30-minutes; and

WHEREAS, such a request needs to be approved by the Borough as there is an ordinance in place prohibiting dogs on the beach prior to September 15; and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of the Borough to allow Booker D. SurfDOG on the municipal beach to promote clean beach awareness.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that Booker D. SurfDOG (the world class surf dog) is hereby allowed to be on the municipal beach for one half hour on Wednesday, September 5, 2018 at 12 noon to promote Clean Beach Awareness and other Clean Ocean Action initiatives and campaigns; and


