

**RESOLUTION No. 191-2019**  
**CONSIDERATION OF BIDS RECEIVED FOR**  
**SHREWSBURY RIVERFRONT PARK IMPROVEMENTS**

Councilmember Leckstein offered the following resolution and moved its adoption; seconded by Councilmember Kelly:

**WHEREAS**, on July 16, 2019, the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright authorized the receipt of bids for the Phase I – Shrewsbury Riverfront Park Improvements Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Clerk did duly advertise on October 3, 2019 to receive bids on October 18, 2019 for Phase I – Shrewsbury Riverfront Park Improvements Project; and

**WHEREAS**, in connection therewith, the Borough Council rejected all bids and authorized the Borough Clerk to re-advertise on November 29, 2019 to receive bids on December 13, 2019 for the Phase I – Shrewsbury Riverfront Park Improvements Project; and

**WHEREAS**, in connection therewith six (6) bids were received by the Borough Clerk on December 13, 2019 from:



**WHEREAS**, the Borough Administrator recommends that a contract be awarded to Capela Construction, Inc., Sicklerville, New Jersey as per their bid proposal for the Phase I – Shrewsbury Riverfront Park Improvements Project at a cost not to exceed \$131,375.00 with the inclusion of add alternate item No. 1 – “Walkways” at a cost of \$23,275.00 for a total contract amount of \$154,650.00; and


