

RESOLUTION NO. 113-2020
AUTHORIZING AN EXTENSION OF THE
GRACE PERIOD FOR THE SECOND QUARTER 2020 TAXES

Councilmember Leckstein introduced and offered for adoption the following Resolution; seconded by Councilmember Birdsall:

WHEREAS, Governor Murphy has issued Executive Order No. 130 allowing municipalities the option to extend the grace period for the second quarter 2020 taxes which are due May 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the current global environment and COVID-19 pandemic, the Borough is desirous of extending the grace period; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, hereby authorize the Tax Collector to extend the grace period for the second quarter 2020 taxes to the permissible deadline of June 1, 2020; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any payments received after the grace period for the second quarter 2020 taxes will be charged interest from the original due date of May 1, 2020 as set by the guidelines set by NJSA 54:4-67 and Resolution No. 24-2020 adopted by the Borough Council at their Re-Organization meeting held on January 4, 2020; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the following:


