

RESOLUTION NO. 116-2020
AUTHORIZING MASER CONSULTING TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT
NJDOT FY2021 MUNICIPAL AID GRANT APPLICATION
FOR BIKEWAY AND WALKWAY IMPROVEMENTS

Councilmember Leckstein* introduced and offered the following Resolution for adoption; seconded by Councilmember Birdsall:

WHEREAS, the Borough Council is desirous of receiving grant funding to enhance and improve roadways for safer biking and foot traffic throughout the community; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) provides municipalities with grant funding to make needed road, bridge, safety, and quality-of-life improvements on local roads; and

WHEREAS, grant funds are now available from the NJDOT's Fiscal Year 2021 State Aid programs, including Municipal Aid, as well as the Transit Village, Bikeway, and Safe Streets to Transit programs; and

WHEREAS, the deadline to apply for the NJDOT grant is July 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Borough Engineer William White of Maser Consulting, has been directed by Borough Council to prepare and submit a grant application for the NJDOT FY2021 Municipal Aid Program for bikeway improvements; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that authorization is hereby given to Borough Engineer, William White of Maser Consulting to prepare and submit the NJDOT FY2021 Municipal Aid Program Grant Application to support safer biking and walking within the Borough.
