Dear Mr. Verruni:

Thank you for the opportunity to submit a response to assist the Borough of Sea Bright with the preparation of a report analyzing the various factors required by N.J.S.A. 18A:13-47.1, et seq. to allow the Borough to petition the Commissioner of Education for approval to join the newly formed Henry Hudson Regional School District. We have put together a proposal to serve as special counsel in connection with this feasibility study.

To provide you with some background, we proudly state that we have participated in almost every significant case over the past 20 years involving the reconfiguration of school districts in the State of New Jersey. We have handled the only three regional school district dissolutions in state history; we have transformed K-6 and K-8 districts into K-12 districts; we have created, expanded and severed sending-receiving relationships; we have transitioned school districts into non-operating school districts in compliance with state law; we have created dual sending-receiving relationships and established additional sending-receiving relationships; and we have helped taxpayers in certain communities save millions of dollars while developing more efficient and comprehensive school systems and negotiating financially beneficial agreements. For your review, we have included a summary of various cases and feasibility studies in the attached materials.

Our proposal is based on the premise that the Borough would retain the Porzio, Bromberg & Newman law firm to facilitate the study. We would bill you at the following hourly rate: \$410.00 for Principals, \$295.00 for Associates, and \$165.00 for Paralegals and would retain the experts on your behalf. The demographic expert, Dr. Richard Grip, is



likely the nation's foremost expert in the field of school demography. He has prepared well over 100 demographic studies for school districts in New Jersey and is the official demographer for the New York City Public Schools. The financial expert is Steven Cea who previously served as the Business Administrator for the Ho-Ho-Kus, West Milford, and Paramus School Districts. Porzio Compliance Services, LLC would provide the consulting for the educational component. The education experts, David Hespe and Mary Robinson Cohen are well versed in this area. Mr. Hespe is the two-time former Commissioner of Education and has extensive expertise with regard to the reconfiguration of public school districts. Ms. Robinson Cohen is a former Superintendent of Schools. The curriculum vitae for each is enclosed.

Our proposal would consist of the preparation of an analysis that would demonstrate that the Borough's withdrawal from the Shore Regional High School District and Oceanport District and subsequent enlargement of Henry Hudson Regional meets the following requirements of *N.J.S.A.* 18A:13-47.1, *et seq.*:

- (2) does not, and is not foreseeably likely to, increase or exacerbate the segregation of students by racial, socioeconomic, disability, or English Language Learner status as determined by the number and percentage of affected students enrolled in the school districts seeking to consolidate or in the regional district or consolidated school district from which a school district is seeking to withdraw;
- (3) consolidates school districts that are in close geographic proximity of each other. School districts need not be immediately contiguous as long as any geographic separation is not so large as to contradict the potential for improved efficiency and cost savings;
- (4) to the maximum extent practicable, reduces student seat time and transportation costs;
- (5) possesses the potential for improved efficiency and cost savings;
- (6) possesses the potential to advance an enhanced learning environment for participating school districts;
- (7) coordinates curriculum across schools and grades throughout the proposed limited purpose or all purpose regional district; and
- (8) reflects a documented commitment from the affected boards of education to make good faith efforts to implement practices that promote efficiency and quality of education. (N.J.S.A. 18A:13¬47.11).

The estimated cost for the preparation of the study is \$22,000 exclusive of legal fees. We estimate the legal fees associated with this analysis to be approximately \$5,000. Should any additional work be requested of the experts beyond the initial study, their time



will be billed out at the following rates: \$275 per hour for Dr. Richard Grip, and Steven Cea; \$300.00 per hour for David Hespe and Mary Robinson-Cohen.

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE GENERAL CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF SEA BRIGHT, CHAPTER 3, ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATIVE CODE"

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Sea Bright that the following revisions to the General Code of the Borough of Sea Bright shall be enacted:

SECTION ONE: Chapter 3, Administrative Code, Sub-section 3-11. Meetings. shall be amended to read as follows with all other sections not mentioned to remain the same:

#### 3-11. Meetings.

There shall be one Regular meeting of the Council and one Workshop meeting each month and adequate notice will be provided according to law. A recessed meeting shall be considered a continuation of a preceding meeting, and the business of the Council shall resume where it was last acted upon. Special meetings can be called by the Mayor or Council and when necessary and adequate notice will be provided according to law. An annual re-organization meeting, known as "Re-organization day," will be held on the first Saturday following January 1st.

**SECTION TWO**. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to die section, paragraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION THREE. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to die extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION FOUR. This ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as provided by law.

# ORDINANCE NO. 02-2024

#### **CALENDAR YEAR 2024**

# ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK

(N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to 2.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright in the County of Monmouth finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2024 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council hereby determines that a 3.5% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$57,339.63 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS the Borough Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, in the County of Monmouth, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2024 budget year, the final appropriations of the Borough of Sea Bright shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$200,678.21. and that the CY 2024 municipal budget for the Borough of Sea Bright be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.
