**WHEREAS**, there are few vacant properties able to house temporary fire house facilities in order to continue fire fighting capabilities in Sea Bright, and

**WHEREAS**, I, Michael Bascom, Chief Financial Officer, certified that funds are available for this specific purpose under Special Emergency.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a certified copy of this resolution be forwarded to the following:


