**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright has been advised that the Borough of Deal is in possession of a 1991 AMG M-92 Truck VIN No. 23A1407, acquired through the Law Enforcement support Office (LESO) 1033 Program, which is no longer needed for use; and

**WHEREAS**, the LESO Program allows for vehicles to be transferred between municipalities and law enforcement agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sea Bright Fire Department wishes to receive the 1991 AMG M-92 truck for their inventory for flood evacuations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Deal has approved the transfer of the 1991 AMG M-92 truck to the Borough of Sea Bright per their Resolution 22-19 dated January 5, 2022, attached hereto; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT BE RESOLVED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that it hereby approves the acquisition of a 1991 AMG M-92 Truck, VIN No. 23A1407 from the Borough of Deal for use by the Sea Bright Fire Department; and
