## SEA BRIGHT POLICE DEPARTMENT OPERATIONS AND COVID-19

As we all prepare and take precautions regarding the coronavirus (COVID-19) rest assured that the Sea Bright Police Department will continue to serve its residents, as well as those that visit and travel through the Borough. The Sea Bright Police Department will be taking precautionary measures to minimize the potential exposure to police officers, staff, and the public. Some of the precautionary measures are as follows:

- When medical assistance is needed, the police dispatcher will be asking specific questions regarding the patient's recent travel, symptoms, and medical history. These questions are necessary to prepare the first responders and ensure they take necessary precautionary measures.
- Calls for service that are minor in nature and do not necessarily require an immediate emergency response may be handled by an officer contacting the caller over the phone and gathering information related to the incident; if deemed necessary, the officer will respond to the location of the incident.
- The Sea Bright Police Department Records Borough will be operating via telephone and email only. All records shall be forwarded via fax and/or email. Please contact the Sea Bright Police Department at (732) 842-0010 or email at [ahendricks@seabrightnj.org](mailto:ahendricks@seabrightnj.org)
- Until further notice, the ABC application process has been suspended. No further ABC applications shall be accepted and current applications will not be furthered.
- Until further notice Resident, Business, and Ocean Avenue Resident parking regulations are suspended; Also, no new permits shall be issued.
