This is to encourage appropriate social distancing requirements in accordance with guidance promulgated by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), State of New Jersey and Monmouth County Health Departments, in conformance with State and Local Executive Orders.

1. A LETTER OF PERMISSION FROM THE PROPERTY OWNER MUST BE SUBMITTED IF THE APPLICANT DOES NOT OWN THE PROPERTY WHERE THE DINING IS TO BE LOCATED.
2. A SKETCH OF THE SITE WITH THE LOCATION(S) OF THE PROPOSED DINING AREA(S) SHOWING THE DIMENSIONS AND LOCATIONS OF ALL TABLES, CHAIRS, TRASH RECEPTACLES AND LIGHT FIXTURES MUST BE SUBMITTED. Please include an explanation of how the area will be separated from the rest of the parking lot or other restaurant areas (if applicable). The seating areas cannot block traffic, obstruct views of oncoming traffic, interfere with parking for or hinder egress from any building. Access must be maintained in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act and all applicable standards.

3. ALL OUTDOOR DINING AREAS MUST BE MAINTAINED AND REMAIN CLEAN AND FREE OF LITTER.
4. TEMPORARY USE PERMITS MAY BE REVOKED FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE OUTLINED SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS, NEW JERSEY STATUTES OR THE BOROUGH OF SEA BRIGHT MUNICIPAL CODE.
5. A COPY OF THE PERMIT MUST BE KEPT ON PREMISES FOR REVIEW BY BOROUGH OFFICIALS ON REQUEST.
6. TEMPORARY USE PERMITS APPROVED PER THIS APPLICATION SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL SEPTEMBER 30, 2020 UNLESS EXTENDED BY THE BOROUGH OF SEA BRIGHT.

The purpose of this permit is to assist businesses coping with the effects of the Public Health Emergency. The activities covered by this permit are permitted subject to compliance with all current or future Executive Orders issued by the Governor or directive issued by the New Jersey State Police. This permit may be revoked at any time without notice if the business engages in an activity which violates an Executive Order or directive from the New Jersey State Police or Borough Ordinance No. 05-2020.

I, the undersigned, will indemnify and hold harmless, the Borough of Sea Bright, its employees, officers and any other associates, from and against any actions, in law or in equity, from liability or claims for damages, demands or judgments to any person or property which may result now or in the future from the issuance of this permit.
