Councilwoman Long introduced a motion amending the time for ticket sales till $4\,\mathrm{pm}$ during the week and continuing to $5\,\mathrm{pm}$ on the weekends.

B. <u>Public Works/Building Department/Public Relations:</u>

Councilman LoBiondo said that the Monmouth County Health Department is warning businesses that they will receive a \$3,000 fine for having cardboard boxes mixed in with garbage.

The corrections workers were here last month helping with striping etc. but this program has been discontinued and we need to budget accordingly.

Public Works department put in dune fencing on Anchorage Beach to help prevent people from walking on the dunes. DPW has been working very hard to prepare the town for the $4^{\rm th}$ of July weekend.

C. Public Safety/Insurance:

Councilman Keeler thanked the police, fire and first aid for a very successful July $4^{\rm th}$ weekend. The NJAW company issued a mandatory water restriction for Monmouth and Ocean Counties.

Holy Cross students received a tour of the Highlands bridge by the Department of Transportation. We will send a letter to DOT thanking them for the tour and there might be another tour this September.

He thanked Chief Sorrentino, Brett Friedman, Pat Mason and all the members of our volunteer fire and first aid services because of the incredible busy July $4^{\rm th}$ weekend. To understand the magnitude of how extremely busy our police were over the July $4^{\rm th}$

weekend, there were 324 traffic stops, 205 summons, 147 parking tickets and NJDMV working with our department gave 78 summons.

Thanks to the acquisition of the Boston whaler the fire department were able to put out the fire on Sedge Island over the July $4^{\rm th}$ weekend.

D. Finance/Grants/Court:

Councilman Murphy said there will be a finance committee meeting to discuss capital projects, the pool project and next year's budget in an effort to work with the new 2% cap.

E. <u>Personnel/Administration/Cultural Arts/Recreation:</u>

Councilwoman Bills said that during a recreation committee meeting they discussed the summer schedule, which includes the Monday drum circle from 7pm - 8pm till the end of August. Beach camp is for the end of August and we are fine tuning the activities. The Blue Claws game is August 20th. The Family Fun Fridays will resume in the fall. The recreation department netted about \$5,000 from the Fireman's fair.

The library committee is seeking donations for the annual November $5^{\rm th}$ Harvest dinner/dance. The library bake and book sale is September $18^{\rm th}$.

F. Smart Growth/Flood Mitigation/Beautification: Councilman Kelly said that the architect is working on plans. We will choose among one of three certified tree specialists to work with us in the Borough. The beautification committee finished the second planting and have plans to plant more flowers at the Sea Bright welcome sign at the foot of the Sea Bright/Rumson bridge.

11. MAYOR FERNANDES - REPORT AND COMMUNICATIONS. Mayor

Fernandes thanked the police department and all the volunteers for their help during the July 4th weekend. Most of all it was fortunate that the fire department just purchased the boat that fought the bush fire on Sedge Island. The coordination during this fire went smoothly in part to Assistant Fire Chief Murphy.

Fort Monmouth is having a celebration from July 16th – $18^{\rm th}$ with a parade, carnival, concert, food, and refreshments.

Mayor Fernandes said that residents should keep in mind the mandatory water restrictions and limit their use of water.

October $20^{\rm th}$, here in Sea Bright will be the flu and pneumonia shots from noon to 1pm.

Senator Beck, Assemblyman Scanlon, Assemblywoman Casagrande will have a symposium on July $14^{\rm th}$ from 6-8pm at the Colts Neck High School on veteran services for veterans and returning National Guardsmen.

Misty Hardwick is the new minister for Sea Bright's Methodist Church.

Our next council meeting is August 3rd.
