

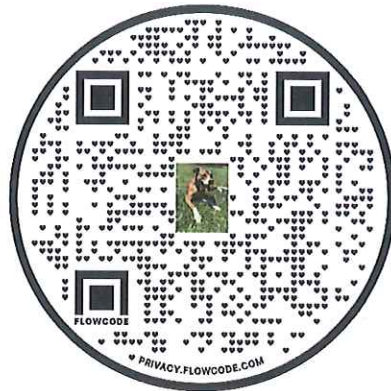
YEARLY CHIP CHECK-UP!

Why the Chip?

- It serves as a permanent form of identification.
- A microchip is about the size of a grain of rice.
- It gets implanted on the back of your pet's neck.
- If you microchip your pet, it is important to register it online with your information.
- If a pet ever gets lost it will be easier to reunite him/her with family.

Taffy's Traveling Chip

- When we adopted Taffy, her microchip was in the right place, but within the first year, we discovered it had traveled to her chest by her left underarm.
- Traveling chips are rare but they do happen and its important to know about



Keep it Updated

- Make sure your pet's chip is registered and the info is up to date: phone, address and even vet info.
- Ask your vet to check your pet's chip at yearly visits.
- Always scan the whole pet in case the microchip has traveled.
