

WHEREAS, Sands Beach Club, 825 Ocean Avenue (Block 23; Lot 13) has submitted a letter to the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Sea Bright requesting permission for a display of fireworks at Sands Beach Club on June 27, 2015 with a rain date of June 28, 2015, and

WHEREAS, such request needs to be approved by the chiefs of the police and fire departments of the Borough of Sea Bright, and

WHEREAS, there is a need for a municipal official to be in charge of the fireworks display which would include, but not be limited to, having the authority to state what area of the beach will be closed off in accordance with fire safety regulations and when the fireworks should begin or be postponed (if necessary); said official shall be the **FIRE OFFICIAL**, and
