# RESOLUTION NO. 60-2015 CONSIDERATION OF AWARD OF CONTRACT PREPARATION OF PLANNING, DESIGN, ENGINEERING AND GRANT ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES FOR THE OCEAN AVENUE STREETSCAPING PROJECT

Councilmember introduced and offered the following Resolution for adoption; seconded by Councilmember :

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Sea Bright has a need for professional services for assistance with the preparation of Planning, Design, Engineering and Grant Administrative Services for Ocean Avenue Streetscaping Project for the Borough; and

**WHEREAS,** request for proposals for professional services for the preparation of Planning, Design, Engineering and Grant Administrative Services in a fair and open contract were advertised on January 21, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough received on February 10, 2015, ten proposals from: 1) Engineering & Land Planning Associates in the amount of \$195,000; 2) Arterial in the amount of \$167,296; 3) RBA in the amount of \$223,000; 4) Avakian in the amount of \$222, 500; 5) Maser in the amount of \$211,000; 6) T&M Associates in the amount of \$127,272; 7) Boswell in the amount for \$219,886; 8) Najarian in the amount of \$194,756; 9) Suburban Consulting in the amount of \$122,515; 10) Atlantic Consulting et al in the amount of \$98,205; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough has received a grant that includes the preparation of Planning, Design, Engineering and Grant Administrative Services for the Borough in the amount of \$1,340,160 from the New Jersey Economic Development Authority; and

**WHEREAS**, a review committee consisting of Borough elected officials and staff has reviewed all proposals received and it was determined that T&M Associates satisfies the requisites contained in the request for proposals, and the committee has recommended, in a memorandum dated March 2, 2015, that they be awarded a contract for the preparation of Planning, Design, Engineering and Grant Administrative Services; and
