WHEREAS, floods are the most common and most destructive natural disasters in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the National Flood Insurance Act authorizes a National Flood Insurance Program ("NFIP"); and

**WHEREAS**, the NFIP is a Federal program created by Congress to mitigate future flood losses nationwide and to provide access to affordable, federally backed flood insurance protection for property owners; and

**WHEREAS**, the NFIP is designed to provide an insurance alternative to disaster assistance to meet the escalating costs of repairing damage to buildings and their contents caused by floods; and

**WHEREAS**, New Jersey is fourth in the nation in the number of NFIP policies enforced and third in total value of claims paid; and

WHEREAS, five hundred and fifty-two communities in New Jersey participate as members of the NFIP which amounts to over 230,000 policies enforced throughout the State of New Jersey; and

**WHEREAS**, the NFIP maintains a significant role in providing financial protection against flood events to New Jersey residents; and

WHEREAS, the NFIP is set to expire on September 30, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, the expiration of this program could cause catastrophic loss of insurance coverage against flooding which is the number one cause of loss of property throughout the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, in the event the program were to expire, the consequences in the form of disruption of coverage and the potential financial burdens to residents throughout the State of New Jersey will be of great economic significance; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of this Resolution is to urge the Borough of Sea Bright Federal Representatives to support the extension of the NFIP which promotes the public health, safety and general welfare and minimizes public and private losses due to flooding events in the State of New Jersey.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that Governing Body of the Borough of Sea Bright hereby urges its Federal Legislators and Representatives to take any and all necessary action to insure that the National Flood Insurance Program is extended beyond the September 30, 2017 expiration date.

# RESOLUTION NO. -2017 CHANGE ORDER NO. 5 (INCREASE) RECONSTRUCTION OF SIX BULKHEADS AND NEW STORMWATER PUMP STATION R. KREMER & SON MARINE CONTRACTORS, LLC

Councilmember introduced and offered the following Resolution for adoption; seconded by Councilmember :

**WHEREAS,** on April 21, 2015, the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright awarded a contract to R. Kremer & Son Marine Contractors, LLC of Brick, New Jersey for the Reconstruction of Six Bulkheads and New Stormwater Pump Station in the contract amount \$1,199,880.00; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 20, 2015, Resolution #101-2015 authorized the re-consideration to the base bid, to include Alternate A1, A2, A3 & A4 as submitted in the original bid package that awarded a contract to the lowest responsible bidder, R. Kremer & Son Marine Contractors, LLC of Brick, New Jersey for the Reconstruction of Six Bulkheads and New Stormwater Pump Station in an new contract amount of \$1,525,705.00; and

**WHEREAS,** the Borough Engineer, Jaclyn Flor, submitted Change Order No. 1 dated October 13, 2015, identifying two unforeseen issues with the bulkhead and storm drain installation on South Street resulting in an increase of \$41,517.25 and various items were reduced to reflect current as-built quantities resulting in a decrease of \$41,520.00 resulting in a net decrease of \$2.75 to the total contract amount; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Engineer, Jaclyn Flor, submitted Change Order No. 2 dated January 5, 2016, identifying a reduction of \$4,080.00 in Items #27, #30 and #A1-15 to reflect the current as-built quantities and Item #10 increased \$4,080.00 to reflect current as-built quantities, resulting in a zero cost change; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Engineer, Jaclyn Flor, submitted Change Order No. 3 dated February 16, 2016, increasing items No. 8, 9 and 24 which include additional paving, drainage items and adding an inlet necessary to avoid an existing unforeseen sanitary lateral at the end of Osborne Place in an amount not to exceed \$26,750.00; and

**WHEREAS,** the Borough Engineer, Francis W. Mullan, submitted Change Order No. 4 dated October 17, 2016: Item 41) an increase of \$6,500.00 for additional construction efforts to remediate the Osbourne Place ponding issues, and Item 37) a decrease of \$6,500.00 due to a revision in the testing requirements for the pump station testing on Osbourne Place, resulting in a zero cost change; and

WHEREAS, Change Order No. 5 dated June 17, 2017, submitted by the Borough Engineer, Francis W. Mullan, will increase the contract by \$1,093.70. The contract will be reduced by the remaining balance for each of the completed Items # 6,8,11, 13-18, 27–30 and A1-16 in the amount of \$41,071.80; extra supplementary items indentified as S-7, S-8, S-9 and S-10 necessary to complete the project will increase the contract in the amount of \$23,415.50; supplementary work necessary to remove concrete around the existing water main on River Street where the water main enters the river is an increase of \$18,750.00; the completion date of Alternate A-2 (River Street) is extended

92 days until September 1, 2017 due to delay of the water main extension by NJAW; the new contracted amount is \$1,590,945.95.
