ORDINANCE NO. 04-2018

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 198, "VEHICLES, ABANDONED", SECTION 198-3, "REMOVAL OF ABANDONED VEHICLES" PERTAINING TO THE REMOVAL OF ABANDONED VEHICLES FROM PRIVATE PROPERTY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Chapter 198, "Vehicles, Abandoned", of the Code of the Borough of Sea Bright, Section 198-3, "Removal of abandoned vehicles", be and the same is hereby amended to read, in full, as follows:

"§ 198-3. Removal of abandoned vehicles.

INTRODUCED: March 20, 2018

CHRISTINE PFEIFFER, CLERK

Whenever any member of the Borough Police Department finds any motor vehicle abandoned on any public street or public highway or public or private property, he shall take possession thereof by removing or securing its removal to such place as may be designated by the Chief of Police. Such taking of possession shall be reported immediately to the Director of the Motor Vehicle Commission on a form prescribed by the Director for verification of ownership."

SECTION TWO. All Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION THREE: If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.
