**No. 110-2018 Authorizing Sewerage Rates and Charges for Second, Third and Fourth Quarters of 2018**

Councilmember Kelly introduced and offered for adoption the following Resolution; seconded by Councilmember Birdsall:

**WHEREAS,** the Governing Body of the Borough of Sea Bright authorized the rates and charges of the municipal public utility for sewerage for the second, third and fourth quarter of 2018; and

**WHEREAS,** any previous schedule of charges adopted by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Sea Bright which are inconsistent herewith are hereby rescinded.

**WHEREAS,** the rates and charges for the utilities are as follows:

1. The 2018 second, third and fourth quarter sewerage rate will be at the rate of \$9.90 for every 1,000 gallons of water consumed by the customer.

2. The charges shall be due and payable in 2018 within 10 days after the due date of the municipal sewer utilities bill. If the bill is not timely paid, the outstanding bill shall be considered a municipal charge and shall be subject to the same rate of interest accruing on delinquent taxes. The second quarter billing in 2018 shall be mailed during July of 2018 which will be for consumption billed by the water company from mid March thru mid June. The third quarter billing in 2018 shall be mailed in October for consumption billed by the water company from mid June thru mid September. The fourth quarter 2018 billing shall be mailed in January 2019 for consumption billed by the water company from mid September thru mid December.

3. Consumption shall be based upon the information provided to the Borough of Sea Bright Municipal Sewer Utility by the New Jersey American Water Company. The customers that are billed by the New Jersey American Water Company on a quarterly basis shall have their sewer charge based upon the quarterly water charges from New Jersey American Water Company. Those customers that are billed on a monthly basis by New Jersey American Water Company shall have their bills based upon their water consumption.

4. All customers of the municipal sewer utility shall be billed for at least 10,000 gallons quarterly. This minimum charge shall be \$99.00 for the second, third and fourth quarters of 2018.

5. The consumption charges shall be billed to the metered townhouse or condominium association or corporation for payment.

6. If any section, subsection, clause or provision of this Schedule of Charges shall be adjudged unconstitutional or to be ineffective in whole or in part, to the extent that it is not adjudged unconstitutional or is not effective, it shall be valid and effective; and no other section, subsection, clause or provision of this Schedule of Charges shall on account thereof be deemed invalid or ineffective and the inapplicability or invalidity of any section, subsection, clause or provision of this Schedule of Rates and Charges in any one or more instances or under any one or more circumstances shall not be taken to affect or prejudice in any way its applicability or validity in any other instances or under other circumstances.

7. A copy of same shall at all times be kept on file at the office of the Tax/Sewer Utility Collector at 1167 Ocean Avenue, Sea Bright, New Jersey and shall at all reasonable times be open to public inspection.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright that the utility is hereby authorized to publish a notice of final adoption of said Resolution of Rates and Charges.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright that they hereby authorize the utility to forward a copy of said Resolution of Rates and Charges to the customers of the utility at the utility's discretion.

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council has received and reviewed the recommendations of the Police Department pertaining to the aforesaid alcoholic beverage license; and

**WHEREAS**, the licensee has recently made application to the Sea Bright unified Planning Board for amended site plan and variance approval pertaining, in part, to the rear dining area and the rear yard area of the premises, which area has been the source of most of the residents expressed concerns; and

**WHEREAS**, during the course of the Planning Board hearing on the aforesaid application, the licensee stipulated to the imposition of certain conditions upon the Planning Board’s approval designed to minimize noise and disturbance to surrounding properties; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council finds that those stipulations and conditions are reasonably designed to address the expressed concerns of the residents who live in close proximity to the licensed premises; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council finds that compliance with those conditions will help to ensure the proper operation of the licensed premises in accordance with applicable local ordinances, alcoholic beverage laws and regulations.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that license number 1343-33-017-005 held by 1030 Liquor Partners, t/a Tommy’s Tavern and Tap be and is hereby renewed for the annual license term commencing July 1, 2018 subject to the following special conditions:

1. The rear outdoor patio dining area, as such area was depicted on the exhibit presented to and approved by the planning board, will be separated from the rear yard gathering space. Such separation and other improvements (including drop down curtain) shall be diligently commenced and completed upon signing, publication and running of appeal period of the planning board resolution of approval.
2. Once installed, gates between the rear yard area and patio dining area will be closed at 10:00 p.m. and all patrons will be directed to vacate the rear yard at that time. There will be no access to the rear yard area after 10:00 p.m.
3. There will be no wait service to the rear yard area—no food or drinks will be served in this area but consumption of food and drinks in the rear yard area shall be permitted.
4. No person will be served food unless they are seated at a dining table or bar in the permitted dining areas.
5. Once installed the drop down curtain on the canopy over the rear dining area on the Northside (“Nautilus Side”) will remain down at all times that the outdoor dining is in use.
