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## RESOLUTION NO. 33-2020 AUTHORIZING A ONE-YEAR RENEWAL OF THE SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE BOROUGH OF OCEANPORT FOR MUNICIPAL COURT FACILITIES

**WHEREAS**, the "Shared Services and Consolidation Act" at N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et. seq. allows a local unit to enter into an agreement with any other local unit or units to provide or receive any service that each local unit participating in the agreement is empowered to provide or receive within its own jurisdiction, including services incidental to the primary purposes of any of the participating local units; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 2B:12-1 allows two or more municipalities to provide jointly for courtrooms, chambers, equipment, supplies and employees for their municipal courts and to agree to appoint the same persons as certified court administrator without establishing a joint municipal court; and

**WHEREAS**, effective on March 1, 2010, the Borough of Sea Bright entered into a shared services agreement with the Borough of Oceanport for municipal court services; and

WHEREAS, the termination date of the Agreement is February 28, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Sea Bright is desirous of renewing the existing shared services agreement with the Borough of Oceanport for an additional one (1) year term for an amount not to exceed \$78,000.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the United States Congress authorized the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) Law Enforcement Support Office (LESO) 1033 Program to make use of excess Department of Defense personal property by making that personal property available to municipal, county and State law enforcement agencies (LEAs); and

**WHEREAS**, DLA rules mandate that all equipment acquired through the 1033 Program remain under the control of the requesting LEA; and

**WHEREAS**, participation in the 1033 Program allows municipal and county LEAs to obtain property they might not otherwise be able to afford in order to enhance community preparedness, response and resiliency; and

**WHEREAS**, although property is provided through the 1033 Program at no cost to municipal and county LEAs, these entities are responsible for the costs associated with delivery, maintenance, fueling, and upkeep of the property, and for specialized training on the operation of any acquired property; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:5-30.2 requires that the governing body of the municipality or county approve, by a majority of the full membership, both enrollment in, and the acquisition of any property through, the 1033 Program; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that the Sea Bright Police Department is hereby authorized to enroll in the 1033 Program for no more than a one-year period, with authorization to participate terminating on December 31 of the current calendar year from January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 8, 2002 then Acting Governor DiFrancesco signed into law the Open Public Records Act (OPRA) which mandates that government records shall be available, with limited exceptions, for public access and simplifying the procedures for requesting such specific records; and

**WHEREAS**, the intent of the law was to provide the public with easy access to government records with an uncomplicated process for obtaining the records and eliminating bureaucratic red tape; and

**WHEREAS,** over the course of 18 years OPRA has been a positive light, but it has also been fraught with abuse and misuse, and has become an unanticipated financial cost to the taxpayers of New Jersey; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Sea Bright has labored under a well-intended law that has spiraled out of control, due to the volume and nature of requests, the cost to taxpayers in responding to the requests, and the potential liability in having to pay disproportionate prevailing party attorney's fees should the requests turn into litigated matters, as well as the liability in determining which documents shall be released, with or without redaction, while attempting to maintain individual privacy; and

**WHEREAS**, it is not only the volume of OPRA requests that challenge our resources, but it is also the cost associated with reviewing, retrieving, and processing the OPRA request(s) by public entity personnel and counsel and possibly defending our action(s) before the Government Records Council or in Superior Court; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Sea Bright received and responded to 145 OPRA requests in 2017, 126 OPRA requests in 2018, and 133 OPRA request in 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, due to the often conflicting case law and Government Record Council decisions, as well as the unique characteristics of OPRA request, the Borough of Sea Bright must often times rely on the municipal attorney to review certain OPRA requests, resulting in additional fees; and

**WHEREAS**, with limited exceptions OPRA has not been amended to address the clear and apparent advancement in technology that has changed the way government records are created, stored, and/or transmitted; the various interpretive decisions; privacy concerns; abuse for commercial gain; and/or the ever increasing cost to taxpayers; and

**WHEREAS**, as the current law approaches its twentieth (20<sup>th</sup>) anniversary it has outgrown its original intended use and has become ripe for comprehensive review and reform;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the governing body of the Borough of Sea Bright appeals to the legislature to form a Commission comprised of Mayors, Municipal Clerks,

Municipal Managers, Attorneys, Police Chiefs, open government advocates, privacy experts, members of the media, citizens and other appropriate stakeholders, to review and examine the effects of OPRA on local government and the needs to be fulfilled by the law, and use the Commission's findings to perform a comprehensive reform of OPRA; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that copies of this resolution be forwarded to Senator Declan O'Scanlon, Assemblywoman Serena DiMaso, Assemblywoman Amy H. Handlin, Assembly Speaker Craig Coughlin, Senate President Stephen Sweeney, Senator Weinberg, Executive Director of the Government Records Council, the Governor of the State of New Jersey, the Municipal Clerks Association of New Jersey and New Jersey State League of Municipalities.

### ORDINANCE NO. 01-2020

### **CALENDAR YEAR 2020**

### ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK

(N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to 2.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright in the County of Monmouth finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2020 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council hereby determines that a 3.5 % increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$47,756.12 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS the Borough Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, in the County of Monmouth, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2020 budget year, the final appropriations of the Borough of Sea Bright shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5 %, amounting to \$167,146.42, and that the CY 2020 municipal budget for the Borough of Sea Bright be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

### ORDINANCE NO. 02-2020

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SEA BRIGHT, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE LEASING OF A ROOM TO THE SEA BRIGHT HISTORICAL SOCIETY

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:12-15(g) provides that a municipality may lease real property for a public purpose to a duly incorporated historical society that provides civic or historic programs or activities; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:12-15(i) further provides that a municipality may lease real property to any nonprofit corporation or association for any activity for the promotion of the health, safety, morals and general welfare of the community; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:12-15, the leasehold shall not exceed 50 years but can be renewed and extended for an additional 25 years by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, The Sea Bright Historical Society (The Society) is a duly incorporated historical society organized for the purpose of providing civic or historic programs or activities and through such activities promote the health, safety, morals and general welfare of the community, which will provide benefits to all residents of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, The Borough has one room space at 1167 Ocean Avenue, the former Borough Hall; and

WHEREAS, The Borough wishes to lease to The Society, and The Society wishes to lease from The Borough, the said room in accordance with a Lease Agreement negotiated between the parties.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, in the County of Monmouth, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The appropriate Borough officials of the Borough of Sea Bright be and are hereby authorized to execute the attached Lease agreement with the Sea Bright Historical Society for a term of one (1) year with the option of two one-year extensions, commencing on a date to be determined, at a monthly rate of ONE (\$1.00) DOLLAR per month and other good and valuable consideration for the premises described in the Lease.

SECTION TWO: The Borough Administrator shall be responsible for the enforcement of the Lease. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-14(c), the Sea Bright Historical Society shall annually submit a report to the Borough Administrator setting out the use to which the leasehold was put during each year, the activities of the lessee undertaken in furtherance of the public purpose for which this leasehold is granted, the approximate cost, if any, of such activities in furtherance of these purposes, and an affirmation of the continued tax-exempt status of the Society pursuant to State and Federal law.

SECTION THREE: All Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION FOUR:** Should any section, paragraph, clause or other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION FIVE: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.
