#### ORDINANCE NO. 08-2020

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 3, "ADMINISTRATIVE CODE", OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF SEA BRIGHT, PROVIDING FOR STIPENDS FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** Chapter 3, "Administrative Code," of the Code of the Borough of Sea Bright, be and the same is hereby amended and supplemented to add thereto the following section:

#### "§3-14. STIPENDS FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS.

- A. Annual stipends for the Mayor; Council President and other members of the Borough Council shall be established in the salary ordinance and shall be set by resolution of the Borough Council.
- B. This section shall apply only to those officials of the Borough elected to terms commencing on or after January 1, 2021 or appointed to fill vacancies thereafter."

**SECTION TWO**: All Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

**SECTION THREE**: If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance.

**SECTION FOUR:** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication as required by law.

## Monmouth County Open Space Grant Application Shrewsbury Riverfront Park

In 2016 the Borough applied for a Monmouth County Open Space Grant to develop the park on the site of the former Anchorage Apartments. This is a matching grant and the Borough had \$100,000 provided by three residents of Rumson that was available for this purpose. We divided the project into two phases to get as much done as possible within the limited budget.

The State DEP was involved in approval of all aspects of the project and continues to be an active participant in the process. The Grant was approved in the Spring of 2017, however there were multiple delays in contracting for the project. The last elements are now being completed.

The 2020 Grant Application is due on September 17<sup>th</sup> and we must review the plans and approve a resolution to submit an application.

Phase one of the Project included the site work to make the area functional as a park:


- Grading
- Stabilized Gravel Pathways
- Fencing
- Signage
- Paver Patio
- Flagpole
- Water Service
- Fish Cleaning Station
- Trash & Recycling Receptacles

The Major elements of Phase two include all remaining elements of the project:

- Ornamental Plantings
- Pavilion Structure
- Sprinkler System
- Benches & Picnic Tables
- Bike Racks
- Reseeding Lawn Areas
- Water Rescue Station
- Site Electric

The Phase one budget was \$200,000. The budget for Phase two is \$160,000. We are partnering with Monmouth Conservation Foundation to raise the matching funds for this application.

Attached is a color rendering of plan for the park has not changed from the original plan that was reviewed in public meetings of the Beautification Committee, and at the Public Hearing for the 2016 Grant Application.

If the County of Monmouth determines that the application is complete and in conformance with the Monmouth County Municipal Open Space Program and the Policy and Procedures Manual for the Municipal Grants Program adopted thereto, the municipality is willing to use the approved Open Space Trust Funds in accordance with such policies and procedures, and applicable federal, state, and local government rules, regulations and statutes thereto; and
- 4. Mayor Brian P. Kelly or his successor is hereby authorized to sign and execute any required documents, agreements, and amendments thereto with the County of Monmouth for the approved Open Space Trust Funds; and
