UPDATES: Beach Replenishment

MANUAL CHECKS

Administrator Verruni explained that we were informed by the NJDEP that the estimates of the cubic yards of sand on the beach by the current contractor were not sufficient to provide the balance of the beach replenishment that we thought we were getting. We anticipated getting replenished from the border of Monmouth Beach to Center Street but they stopped midway through Tradewinds. Mr. Verruni said he was told that these were only estimates for our costs and then they went out to bid which came in much higher than expected so they only awarded the base bid. Nonetheless it would be additional funding for all towns if we want to complete that portion of the project. We will have to make this decision whether we want to complete this project to Center Street. Sea Bright would be responsible for 25% of which the County would pay 10%. Council agreed that we must complete the replenishment to Center Street. Mr. Verruni will bring this item to the next workshop meeting for further discussion.

EXECUTIVE SESSION
