No. 155-2022 Compliance with Promulgation of Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey accepting the Borough of Sea Bright 2022 Annual Audit

Councilmember Keeler introduced and offered for adoption the following Resolution, seconded by Councilmember Birdsall:

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 5-4 requires the governing body of every local unit to have made an annual audit of its books, accounts and financial transactions, and

WHEREAS, the Annual Report of Audit for the year 2021 has been filed by a Registered Municipal Accountant with the Municipal Clerk pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A: 5-6, and a copy has been received by each member of the governing body; and

WHEREAS, R.S. 52:27BB-34 authorizes the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey to prescribe reports pertaining to the local fiscal affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Local Finance Board has promulgated <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 5:30-6.5, a regulation requiring that the governing body of each municipality shall, by resolution, certify to the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey that all members of the governing body have reviewed, as a minimum, the sections of the annual audit entitled "Comments and Recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the members of the governing body have personally reviewed, as a minimum, the Annual Report of Audit, and specifically the sections of the Annual Audit entitled "Comments and Recommendations, as evidenced by the group affidavit form of the governing body attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, such resolution of certification shall be adopted by the Governing Body no later than forty-five days after the receipt of the annual audit, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-6.5; and

WHEREAS, all members of the governing body have received and have familiarized themselves with, at least, the minimum requirements of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey, as stated aforesaid and have subscribed to the affidavit, as provided by the Local Finance Board; and

WHEREAS, failure to comply with the regulations of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey may subject the members of the local governing body to the penalty provisions of $\underline{R.S.}$ 52:27BB-52, to wit:

R.S. 52:27BB-52: A local officer or member of a local governing body who, after a date fixed for compliance, fails or refuses to obey an order of the director (Director of Local Government Services), under the provisions of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, may be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both, in addition shall forfeit his office.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SEA BRIGHT, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE PRIVATE SALE OF NON- CONFORMING REAL PROPERTY KNOWN AS A PORTION OF BLOCK 23, LOT 1 TO CONTIGUOUS PROPERTY OWNERS PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A;12-13(B)(5)

WHEREAS, NJSA 40A:12-13(B)(5) authorizes the sale of municipally owned property which is less than the minimum size required for development under the Municipal Zoning Ordinance; and which is without any capital improvement thereon, to the owners of contiguous real property; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has found and determined that a portion of the real property designated as Block 23, Lot 1 aforesaid (hereinafter the "Property") will not be needed for public use and may be offered for sale to the contiguous owners pursuant to the cited statues; and

WHEREAS, the Property extends westward from the current border of Block 22, Lot 1, 10.42 feet and runs the length of Block 22, Lot 1, which is 54.86 feet and is more fully described by the legal description attached as Schedule A; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Assessor of the Borough of Sea Bright has recommended the sale of the subject lot with a minimum bid price of \$25,000.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION I

Within five (5) days following final enactment of this ordinance, the Borough Clerk shall post on the regular Borough Hall bulletin board and advertise in a newspaper circulating in the Borough, a notice setting forth the following information as to the sale of a portion of Block 23, Lot 1 on the Borough of Sea Bright Tax Map, whose sale is hereby authorized. A copy of this notice shall be mailed by certified mail by the Borough Clerk to all contiguous property owners of the property being offered for sale within the aforesaid five (5) day period.

TAKE NOTICE that an ordinance of the Borough of Sea Bright adopted pursuant to NJSA 40A:12-13(b)(5) on the Borough of Sea Bright offers for sale the following property to contiguous property owners under the following terms and conditions:

Property offered for Sale: a portion of Block 23, Lot 1 of the Borough of Sea Bright Tax Map;

Minimum Price: \$25,000.00;

All offers must be made within twenty (20) days following this advertisement at not less than the minimum price above;

Deed Restriction: The Property shall be precluded from further sale as a separate lot by the contiguous owner purchasing said property pursuant to this Ordinance and shall be consolidated with the adjacent property. The Property will have no further development except a canopy structure with support legs, with a retractable cover, covering the area shown on the diagram attached as Schedule B, may be constructed subject to all necessary approvals and permits. However, permanent walls are prohibited. The Purchaser must construct a sidewalk extension and curbing per the diagram attached hereto as Schedule B, although the sidewalk and curbing will remain on the Borough's property. Such sidewalk must match in height and appearance the existing sidewalk and must have an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessible access toward East Ocean Avenue in addition to maintaining any other ADA accessible accesses already in place. If the Property is used for patrons of the restaurant establishment safety bollards and/or wall and/or fence must be placed around the perimeter at the discretion of the Borough's Planning Board. All of the foregoing will be completed by and be at the sole expense of the purchaser and will be subject to any applicable permitting requirements.

The sale is made subject to all restrictions, covenants, restrictions and conditions of record, with said property being sold in an "as is" condition and is being sold subject to such other facts that an accurate, certified survey would reveal. The sale is further subject to the purchaser obtaining

subdivision, and site plan approval if required, to consolidate the Property for use with the contiguous property. Nothing in this sale shall affect the right to lawful occupancy of use of the Property by any municipal or private utility to occupy or use the Property as lawfully occupied or used by it.

Any contiguous property owner desiring to make an offer for the purchase of the property being offered for sale herein shall, within twenty (20) days following advertisement of this notice or a receipt of a mailed copy of this notice, make an offer in writing by certified mail addressed to the Borough Council c/o Borough Clerk, Borough of Sea Bright, 1099 Ocean Avenue, Sea Bright, NJ 07760 at no less than the minimum price set forth hereinabove. All bids must be received no later than 12:00 p.m. on September 29, 2022, all bids must be marked "Sealed Bid Enclosed".

The Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright reserves the right to reject any and all offers, and shall accept or reject any offer within thirty (30) days of the advertisement of this public notice. If the Borough Council fails to accept or reject any offer within the aforesaid time period, all offers will be deemed rejected. Where there is more than one owner with real property contiguous to the property being offered for sale, the subject property will be sold to the highest bidder or offer from among all such owners submitting an offer as provided for herein. All offers shall be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the offer made, payable to the Borough of Sea Bright; the balance shall be paid at closing of title.

A meets and bounds description must be provided by the successful bidder within twenty (20) days after the acceptance of the offer by the Borough Council.

The closing of title shall be by a bargain and sale deed without covenants as to grantor. Closing shall take place no later than ninety (90) days after the acceptance of the offer by the Borough Council. The Borough of Sea Bright makes no representation as to the condition or marketability of title as to the subject property.

In addition to the purchase or offer price, it shall be the responsibility of the successful bidder to pay at closing the advertisement and mailing costs in connection with this sale and the Borough Attorney's fee for the preparation of the deed in connection with this sale. If the successful bidder

or offer shall fail to close title through no fault of the Borough, the successful bidder or offerer shall forfeit the deposit made for the sale, which shall be retained by the Borough as liquidated damages, except in the event the successful bidder or offerer is not successful in obtaining subdivision and site plan approval to develop the Property with the contiguous property, the Borough shall return the deposit to the successful bidder and neither party shall have any further obligation to the other with regard to the Property.

The Borough Clerk shall file with the Director, Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs, a sworn affidavit verifying publication of advertisement as required by this ordinance.

SECTION II

All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION III

If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication as required by law.

MAYOR AND COUNCIL COMMENTS

Mayor Kelly announced that he is working on the plans for the 10-year anniversary of Superstorm Sandy. The Fire Department is allowing us to utilize their space for the afternoon event (4pm-7pm) which will be open to the public with speakers, live music, and food. There will be a small, invitation only, ceremony at 9am in the Pavilion. Local summer has officially started and he commended all departments for a very successful season. Mayor Kelly added the school regionalization negotiations and discussions continue - nothing is finalized. As it stands now, it doesn't look like there will be a referendum question on the ballot this November.

Councilman Birdsall shouted out DPW for a great job this summer especially being a man down for the first half. Our new Deputy Director of Public Works, Rob, has quickly fit in and is doing well. The beach department has done a great job too.

Councilman Lamia announced that October 22nd is the Library's Fall Festival at Eventide and the flyer will be out shortly.

Councilman Keeler commended all our volunteers on the Fire and First Aid Squads. He thanked Chief Murphy and Deputy Chief Rivera for spending hundreds of hours supervising, conducting, and scheduling all the members of the Fire Department. He also commended Antony Toth, Dave Estelle and Kelsey from the First Aid Squad. Additionally, he thanked Chief Friedman, Captain Arias and Lieutenant McCue and the rest of the Police Department staff for keeping our town safe during such a busy summer. Councilman Keeler said he spoke with Carol Smith at the court and everything is going well and they are very pleased with operations overall – if anyone is interested in attending the next court date is September 15th. The Fire Department is having an open house on October 9th from 12pm-3pm. Discussions are continuing with the DOT about the safety solutions at the Highlands bridge, the crosswalk at Center Street as well as other crosswalks.

Councilman Bieber reported the Cannabis Committee had its 3rd meeting last week and reminded everyone that the open meeting with residents will be tomorrow, Wednesday September 7th and Thursday September 8th in the meeting room in the Beach Pavilion from 7pm-9pm. Furthermore, there are additional meetings scheduled with merchants and potential businesses and looks forward to good engagement. The Administration Committee has drafted a short-term rental ordinance which he plans to discuss at the next workshop meeting so we can move forward with introduction and final adoption in October.

Councilman Booker reported the audit has been received without any issues or recommendations and commended our Administration team for being the excellent professionals that they are and for doing the great job that they do.
