WHEREAS, the Borough of Sea Bright wishes to purchase, under State Contract No. A88726, T2100, a 2018 Ford F250 Extended Cab Pickup Truck from Cherry Hill Winner Ford, 250 Haddonfield-Berlin Road, Cherry Hill, NJ 08034 for a base amount of \$30,552.00 and with emergency and plow equipment in the amount of \$7,560.00 for a total cost of 38,122.00; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the requirements of the Local Public Contract Law N.J.S.A. 40:11-12 et seq., and the regulations promulgated thereunder, the purchase of goods and services by local contracting units without competitive bids is authorized from vendor(s) with state contracts.
