Avakian, Inc., submitted Change Order No. 1, dated July 9, 2021, for an increase of \$15,100.00 which includes: 1) Item No. SA1-1 – Pipe addition for material from PVC to DIP for \$10,600.00, and 2) Item No. SA1-2 – Extra Inlet a Riverway Doghose for \$4,500, resulting in an increase to the original contracted amount to \$325,100.00; and
