

RESOLUTION NO. 127-2022
BOROUGH OF SEA BRIGHT
SUPPORTING THE ENACTMENT OF ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 1100
AND SENATE BILL NO. 995

Councilmember Bieber offered the following resolution and moved its adoption; seconded by Councilmember Booker:

WHEREAS, removing abandoned lines from poles and other structures must be carefully managed by utility companies; and

WHEREAS, the public right of way is a limited asset and must be protected for our resident's safety and to preserve the character of our community and maintain their availability for current and future uses; and

WHEREAS, removal of above ground lines that have been abandoned is a positive step towards maintaining this public asset.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that it hereby affirms its support for the enactment of A-1100 and S-995.


